

PROPOSAL FOR STUDENT PUB

1. Surrey Campus Council has decided that social activities at Douglas College are not consistent with the activities of the majority of post-secondary institutions. As many of our students are of adult age we feel activities should be provided more in keeping with their age. We feel that a Student Pub would help achieve these ends.
2. Location of the pub would be in Surrey Campus cafeteria on Friday or Saturday evenings for 8 P.M. to 12 A.M. No admission after 12 P.M. Liquor sales to stop at 1 A.M. and the cafeteria to be cleared by 1:30 A.M.
3. Setup for cafeteria:
 - 1) Entrance and exit only through west doors.
 - 2) Emergency exit through center and east doors.
 - 3) Identification table by west doors.
 - 4) Bar by east doors. Cashier table beside bar.
 - 5) Entertainment (if provided) in south corner.
4. No person without adequate identification will be permitted in the cafeteria. Adequate identification will be a Liquor Control Board card or a new provincial driver's license (with picture).
5. Admittance will be to three hundred people or less as required by fire regulations. One guest per Douglas student with card. No alcoholic bought beverage will be consumed outside cafeteria. No person will be permitted to enter or leave with alcoholic beverage on his person.
6. Beverage sales will be conducted in such a manner that a person must buy tokens from a cashier. These tokens will have trade-in value with the bartender for beverages.
7. Control: The pub will be operated by a paid manager selected by Surrey Campus Council. The manager will be responsible directly to Surrey Campus Council.
working with the manager:
 - 2 paid students at the door will be responsible for checking identification.
 - 2 paid commissioners to watch other doors and clean tables.
 - 1 paid bartender for dispensing beverages.
 - 1 paid cashier for selling tokens for the purchase of beverages.
 - 1 professional security guard or one off duty policeman to patrol outside area.
 - 2 paid persons responsible for clean-up.

No person hired by the council will be permitted to consume alcoholic beverages.

8. The price of beverages will be:
 beer and cider
 3 bottles for one dollar and one bottle for fifty cents.
 wine
 fifty cents a cup
 Beer and cider will be served in bottles (no glasses)
 Wine will be served in paper cups.
 Beverages will be bought from the L. C. B. and be
 transported by a hired delivery firm.
9. The liquor license will be obtained by the manager. The
 manager will be made aware of all the responsibilities this
 entails.
10. Surrey Campus Council will be responsible for losses
 incurred by the pub. Any profit will be donated to a student
 emergency loan fund to be administered by the college
 financial aid officer under the direction of the college
 student council.
11. Food will be supplied by Amco machines presently
 located in the cafeteria.
12. Advertising will only be carried on within Douglas College.
13. Live entertainment may be provided at times in which case
 admission may be required at the door to cover the cost of
 the entertainment.
14. In the event of any disturbance Surrey R. C. M. P. will be
 notified immediately.
15. This proposal will come up for negotiation with the
 election of each new student government.
