Canadian Wanderings

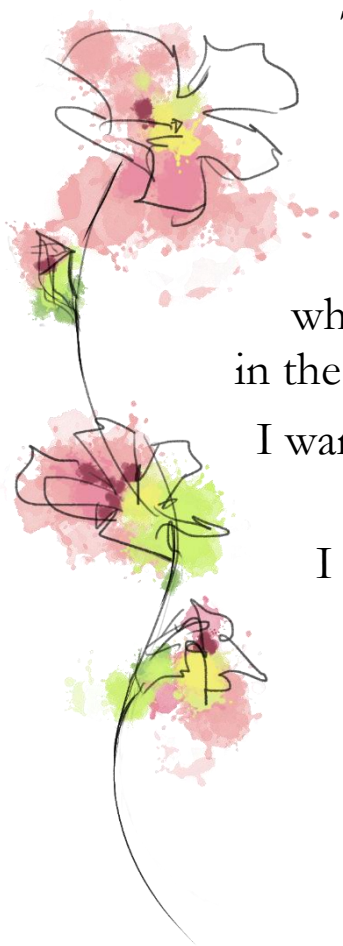
Going to school through forests;
