As we can see the situation is getting worse in all three sectors of Beijing due to water shortage.

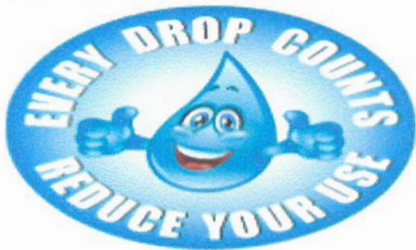
