queer, and neurodiverse identities.

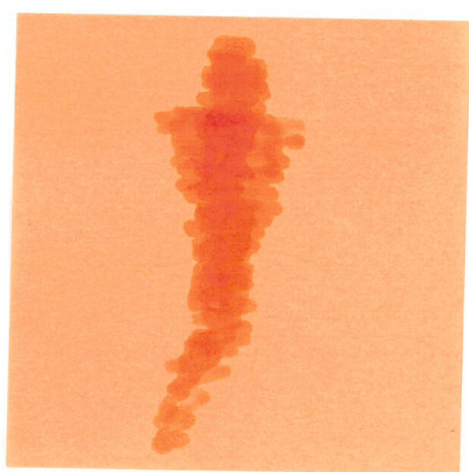
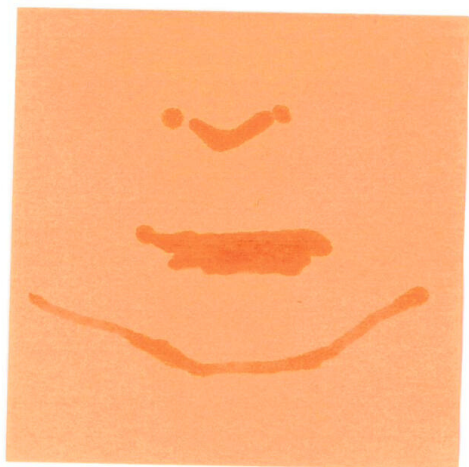
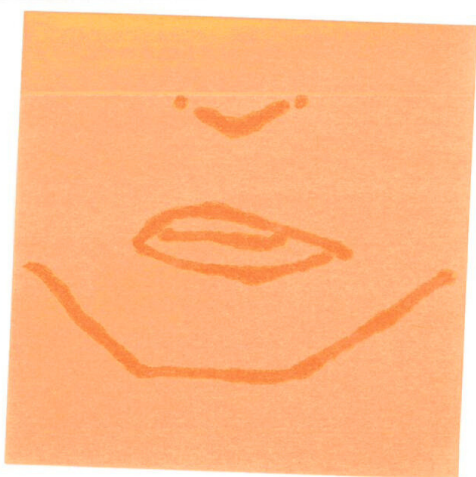
Milo then led the group in a mini

just 4 panels.

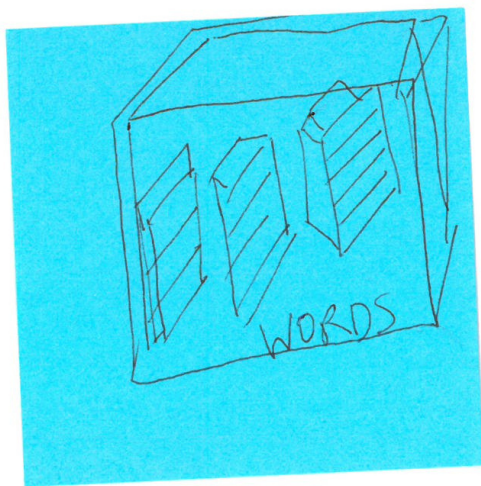
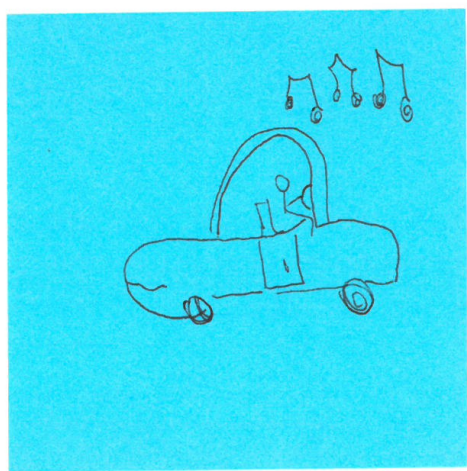
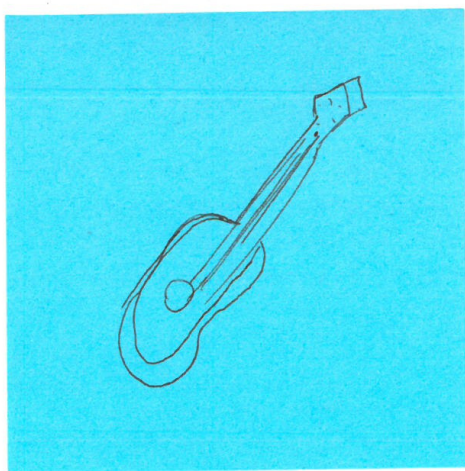
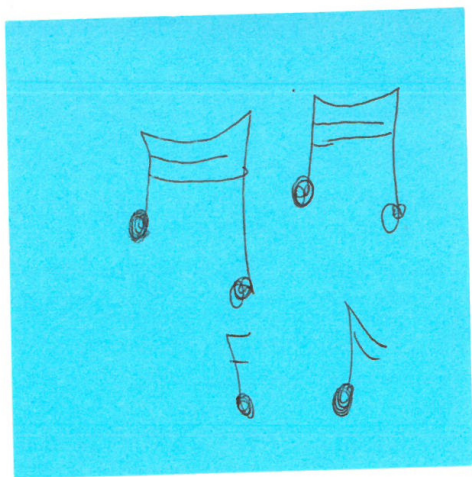
